

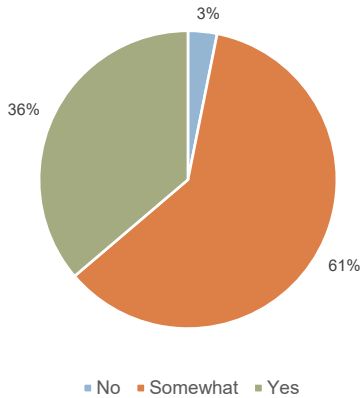

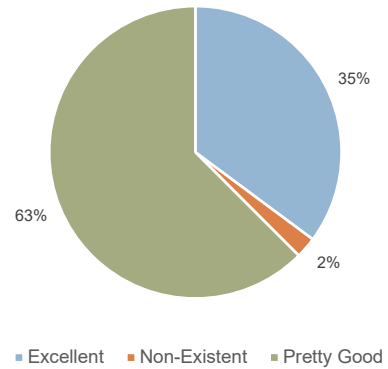

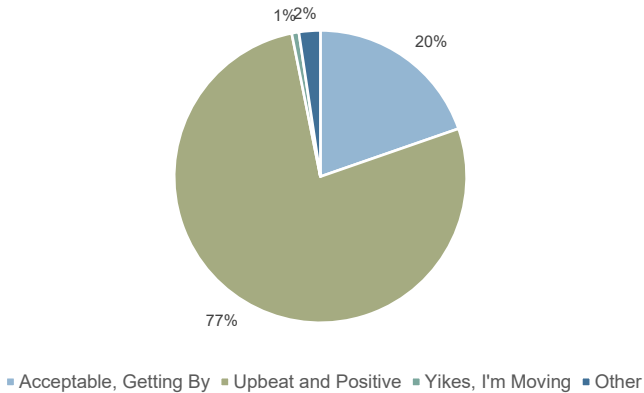
Do you feel like you know your neighbors?



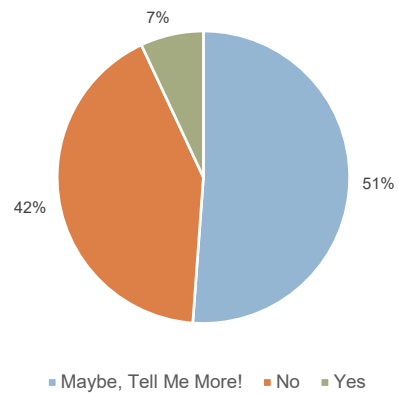
Quality of relationships in Warfleigh?



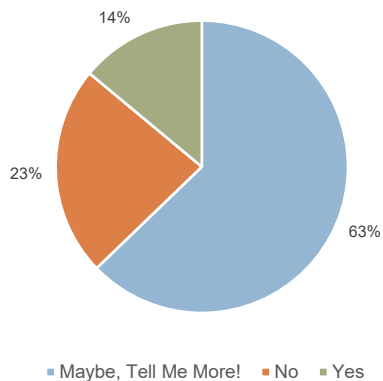
What is your overall attitude about Warfleigh?



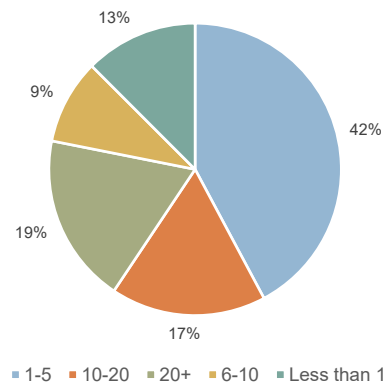
