- Welcome & Call to order – WNA board members introduced themselves and Libby called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM
- Canal & levee update - Edwin Morris, Operations & Maintenance Supervisor, Citizens Energy Group
 - Bid is out to start dredging the canal next spring.
 - CEG is working on facilitating getting the bids.
 - Work will include removing the growing pond weeds
 - Edwin provided his email address in order to contact him with any concerns, questions or requests. emorris@citizensenergygroup.com
 - Edwin also stated that sometimes CEG completes maintenance work on behalf of/instead of DPW to get it done in a more timely manner.
- INRC grant update - current state of sign project:
 - \$10,000 grant was awarded for installation of 6 signs at key entry points to the neighborhood including our “Between The Waters” logo.
 - Signs will be attached to IPL and Verizon poles.
 - No date yet for completion of installation but fabrication is about to begin.

- Sidewalk survey update:
 - Survey has been completed with people going through and photographing and rating nearly every bit of the sidewalk in our neighborhood.
 - Will be submitted to DPW.
 - Many thanks to Steve and all the neighbors who helped survey the streets
- DPW project - 64th / Arden Drive & Meridian St
 - Meridian Street resurfacing and drainage project to begin in spring, 2023.
 - Substantial drainage improvements are a large part of the project.
 - Pavement markings which will narrow lanes and widen medians will be added to slow traffic in the residential portions of the limits of the project.
 - Included in the project will be a new traffic signal at the intersection of Meridian and 64th St/Arden Drive with marked crosswalks and median refuge areas.
- Warfleigh resident Clint Leer had contacted WNA to begin discussion about the dangers of driving on Riverview, reporting on an apparently speeding driver hitting cars in front of residence and causing major damage. The WNA has had other complaints and is researching.
- Misc dates and upcoming events of note:
 - Monumental Marathon came through the neighborhood on Nov 5
 - City leaf collection dates – Monday, Nov 7 through Friday, Dec 2
 - (White River Alliance Stormwater Training)

New in 2022, the Stormwater Landscape Maintenance Training is available as an online course through our LearnDash platform. The training consists of 10 modules of video presentations that you can

take at your own pace, simple (and voluntary) quizzes, and helpful resources that you can download or print.
